Accomplished military veteran delivers commencement speech

COLORADO SPRINGS, COLO. (July 15, 2010) – Colorado Technical University (CTU) Colorado Springs recently graduated 180 students during a commencement ceremony held at the Crowne Plaza hotel in Colorado Springs.
