NOTES:

1. Tuition is charged per credit hour at the beginning of each term throughout the student's program. Each academic term is 10 weeks and includes two 5 week sessions. Students may be required to complete some coursework for their program via online delivery.
2. Book supplies and course materials charges are derived by taking a weighted net average cost per course multiplied by the number of courses in the term. The average cost of course materials varies by degree type. For all students eligible for the military tuition rate, the course materials charge will be posted to a student's account once each term, after the add drop period. The charge will then be waived, resulting in no net cost to the student. The Total Program Cost includes a custom suite of course materials which are provided to the student by Words of Wisdom, LLC. At the University's discretion, books may be delivered in an electronic (e-Book), which may be accessed by the student for the duration of the applicable course(s) or a standard textbook, which becomes the property of the student. Students not wishing to use e-Books are responsible for any additional charges associated with purchasing standard textbooks.
3. Total Program Cost displayed is based upon the total number of credits in a degree program. Fees charged by the University are included in the Total Program Cost. For all students eligible for the military tuition rate, the Graduation Fee, Student Setup Fee & Technology Fee are not charged and therefore not included in the Total Program Cost. The total number of credits taken at Colorado Technical University may vary due to transfer credits, block transfer, repeated courses, or multiple concentrations. Students possessing an earned Associate degree from an accredited institution at the time of admission to Colorado Technical University may be eligible for a block transfer of credits into select Bachelor's degree programs. See the Degree Programs section of the University Catalog for descriptions of the degree programs.
4. Military tuition rate cannot be combined with CTU scholarships/grants unless specifically noted in the University Catalog.
5. The University reserves the right to change tuition and fees during the course of an academic year. As such, a student's financial aid packaging may be subject to adjustment to account for these monetary changes.
6. For students enrolled in the Associate of Science in Electronics Technology, Bachelor of Science in Computer Engineering and Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering programs, a \$1,100 non-refundable Engineering Fee will be charged to the student's account in the term in which the student is registered for the first engineering (EE) course and is included in the Total Program Cost. This fee does not cover the cost of these required items: safety goggles, one Phillips head screwdriver, one flat head screwdriver, and one set of needle nose pliers with side cover; it is the student's responsibility to purchase these items. Engineering students are also responsible for purchasing any replacement parts listed on the Engineering Parts List; this list is available to students to assist in purchasing replacement parts.

Cost of Attendance

The cost of attendance (COA), is the average academic year education-related cost for attending a program at an institution of higher education. Expected charges include direct costs, such as tuition and fees, and indirect costs (not directly charged by the school), such as room and board, travel, books and supplies, and other personal expenses. The COA will differ based on various circumstances, such as your enrollment status and living situation. Students receiving Military Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) should reference the ‘BAH’ components below. All other students should reference the ‘Off-Campus’ components below.

Below are the COA components for the 2025-2026 academic year. At CTU, a full time academic year consists of three terms, which is generally eight months in length.
